

Non-Native producers average \$27, 225 Lower net farm income is one contributing factor to credit access in Indian Country food and agriculture.


Top AI/AN Produced Crops⁵










2015 FDPIR Sites USDA Food Environment Atlas


2016 % SNAP Eligibility USDA Food Environment Atlas
