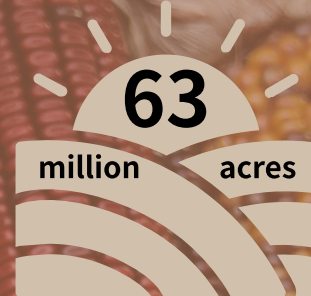




INDIAN COUNTRY BACKGROUND

A Brief Overview of USDA Ag Census 2022

The 2022 Census of Agriculture recorded American Indian/Alaska Natives farm more than 63 million acres of land.



The total number of farms counted that are owned/operated by AIAN producers is 58,336. While this is a slightly lower count than the 2017 census, the number of total acres counted increased by more than 4 million.

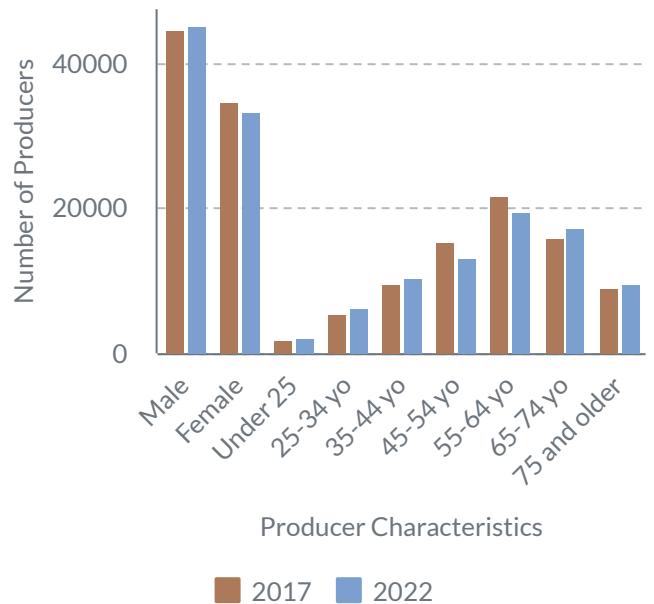
