


Market Value of Products Sold







Indian Country's Economic Impact 2007 - 2022


Prices are 29.15% higher in 2022 than they were in 2007

There has been a trend of \bullet moderate inflation in feed prices due to factors like rising production costs and increasing demand for feed inputs.



FARM EQUIPMENT


